I was fortunate enough to be selected to teach for the Johns Hopkins University Center for Talented Youth for three weeks this summer in La Jolla, California. Having never visited California (or the west coast region, at all), it was an incredible, novel experience. Although I may not be as much a movie aficionado as our president, Chris Woods, I felt like everywhere I went, I saw a scene straight from a movie (as many films are recorded right there in California; pic above).



They were nice enough to provide me with free board at a dorm on the University of California, San Diego campus, where I shared a large suite (with full kitchen) with

two administrators for the program. Upon entering campus and waiting to check into my room, I was greeted by a cute Western Fence Lizard on some steps on campus (pictured above), which was a pleasant surprise.



My classroom was located in a Physics classroom at the upper (high) school on La Jolla Country Day School campus, which was located a mere 8 miles away from the Marine Corps Air Station Miramar (which was the original setting for the movie, Top Gun). I taught 11 students (pictured above) who had just finished third or fourth grade a course entitled, Through the Microscope. These students ended up gaining more experience with microscopes (both dissecting and compound) than most students do until grad school, so this was an incredible opportunity for them to get a leg-up on their future careers in biology, science, or medicine. I would love to be able to do this again next year and every year after, as these students and my fellow faculty/staff members were absolutely incredible!

Meeting of the Minds Commentary



At the Meeting of the Minds gathering on July 10th, the topic chosen for discussion was "The Global Crisis in Conservatism." It was based on an Op-Ed piece in the July issue of the Economist magazine. The gist of the article was that what passes for conservatism today is really a nationalist populism and repudiation of the world order since the mid-20th Century.

The article cited the trends toward nationalist populism in Europe, particularly in Spain, Italy, Hungary, and Poland. Other examples were Britain's attempt to divorce from Europe by Brexit, the U.S. and immigration/trade under Trump, and Brazil under a right-wing president.

It also points out how the new right denies science, tolerates the conduct of Donald Trump, and how angry, reactionary nationalism kindles suspicion, hatred, and division. In spite of all this, the new right is clearly winning its fight against Enlightenment conservatism. The new right is implacably hostile to classical liberalism. Without a balance between Left and Right, voters may be left without a choice.
